F.I.T.A. and METRICS 1 to 4

FINAL DETAILS

- DATE:** 17th & 18th July Gates open at 7am Registration opens at 8am. Please sign in on arrival. .Assembly: 8.30am Practice 8.40 am to 9.25am Start 9.30am. Each distance takes about 90 minutes. Lunch is usually 1 hour
- VENUE:** Tolworth Court, Kingston University Sports Ground, Old Kingston Road, KT4 7QH
Turn off A214 at traffic lights into Old Kingston Road. Please park where directed. Nearest railway station is Tolworth. See below for maps.
- ROUND:** FITA.Men, Women, Junior and Cadets plus Metrics 1 to 5 for other Juniors
- EQUIPMENT:** There will be an equipment check during practice. Practice is not compulsory but there are no sighters as in GNAS competitions. There is only practice at the longest distance.
- LADY PARAMOUNT:** Judy Friedlander
- JUDGES:** **Chief Judge** Ted Burnham **Director of Shooting** Andy Turner (candidate judges)
Kevin Thurlow, Stan Bartosz, Robert Potts, Netta Bridle, Victoria Hinchcliffe (candidate. judge)
- SCORING:** 10 zone scores, including 10's and X's. Please note that it is the responsibility of each archer to ensure that their final score and the totals of tens and X's recorded on the score sheet are correct. Please will archers keep an accurate record of their own scores as the competition goes on and check all the totals before signing the score sheet. Juniors may wish to get their parents or another adult to check their scores with them. Bring a calculator if you need it. ***The final score of an archer, and any record claim, may be declared void if the signed score is later found to be higher than the correct total.***

There will be slips to complete the score for each archer at the end of every 3 dozen arrows, and on the 2nd and 3rd distances this will also include the running score, as shown below. There is one slip for each target and it only needs to be filled in for the 1st, 2nd and 3rd distances, we will use these scores to calculate the running leader board after each distance. The leader board will be a printed list posted on the shooting line. It will also allow the organiser to spot any errors in running totals before it is too late.

- WEB SITE:** Full information <http://chessington-bowmen.org.uk/surreystar2010/>
- BEHAVIOUR:** Please note that smoking is not permitted on the shooting line or in the area of the tents/chairs. Taking alcohol during the competition is **not** permitted under FITA anti-doping rule P1. This is a restriction which many archers will not be used to compared to previous Surrey Championships, please respect the World Record status of this event.
- CLOTHING:** FITA Dress Regulations. (**Green** / **White** / **registered club colours only**.)

DRUG TESTING	This World Record Status Shoot will be liable for drug testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply; if they refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result. Written parental consent must be provided for Juniors either prior to the competition or on the day.
CHANGES:	If there are any changes to details for an archer, for example, a change of handicap, please email the organiser. Only County archers who have submitted a handicap are eligible for the handicap awards.
CANCELLATIONS:	If an archer is unable to, or chooses not to, compete please could they either email the organiser as soon as possible, or if it is within 48 hours of the start time please send a text to the organiser on 07958464616. There is a waiting list for most classes so please don't waste a place. Refunds are at the discretion of the organiser. Archers on the waiting list may get a text message at short notice to say a place is available. Please reply promptly to say if the place is still required. Should the event be cancelled at short notice due to bad weather or other emergency the organiser will place the information on the web site and try to contact the named contact for each club by email or by text. There will be no refunds for cancellation of the whole event.
AWARDS:	See web site for further details
LIABILITY	Neither the CSAA nor Kingston University can accept liability for property or vehicles on the ground.
PARKING:	There is some parking behind the tent line and plenty of space to the right of the shooting area.
CATERING	1 st Tolworth Scouts will provide an all day BBQ and refreshments for sale from 8am.
DOGS	NO DOGS ARE ALLOWED ON THE GROUND UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCE.
PHOTOGRAPHY	Please sign in if you intend to carry out any form of photography. If the parent of a child objects to their photo being taken please contact the organiser.
TOILETS:	There will be portable toilets, including a disabled unit, behind the shooting line
CLAIMS:	Please see the organiser immediately after the event for record claim forms.
HOT WEATHER:	I know that it is stating the obvious, but please remember this can be the hottest time of the year so do allow 3 litres of fluids per person and take precautions to protect your skin from the sun if you are susceptible to sun burn. Sunshine can not be guaranteed but do be prepared if it is hot.
TROPHIES:	Please remember to return any Championship trophies won last year. If you win a trophy you will need to sign your name

FITA. Rules of Shooting will apply; including observation of FITA Dress Regulations. Please be prepared to show GNAS cards. Only members of GNAS or FITA are permitted to shoot

Rules applied for this FITA round

- Sound-controlled timing with lights and count down timing,
- Four archers per target, two per detail, shooting in alternate details
- One end of 6 arrows shot in 240 seconds (4 minutes)
- One end of 3 arrows in 120 seconds at the two shorter distances.
- Two longest distance use full size 122cm face, two shortest distance use an 80cm face, longest distance first
- Arrow holes must be marked, bouncers allowed. Score sheets show 10's and X's scored.

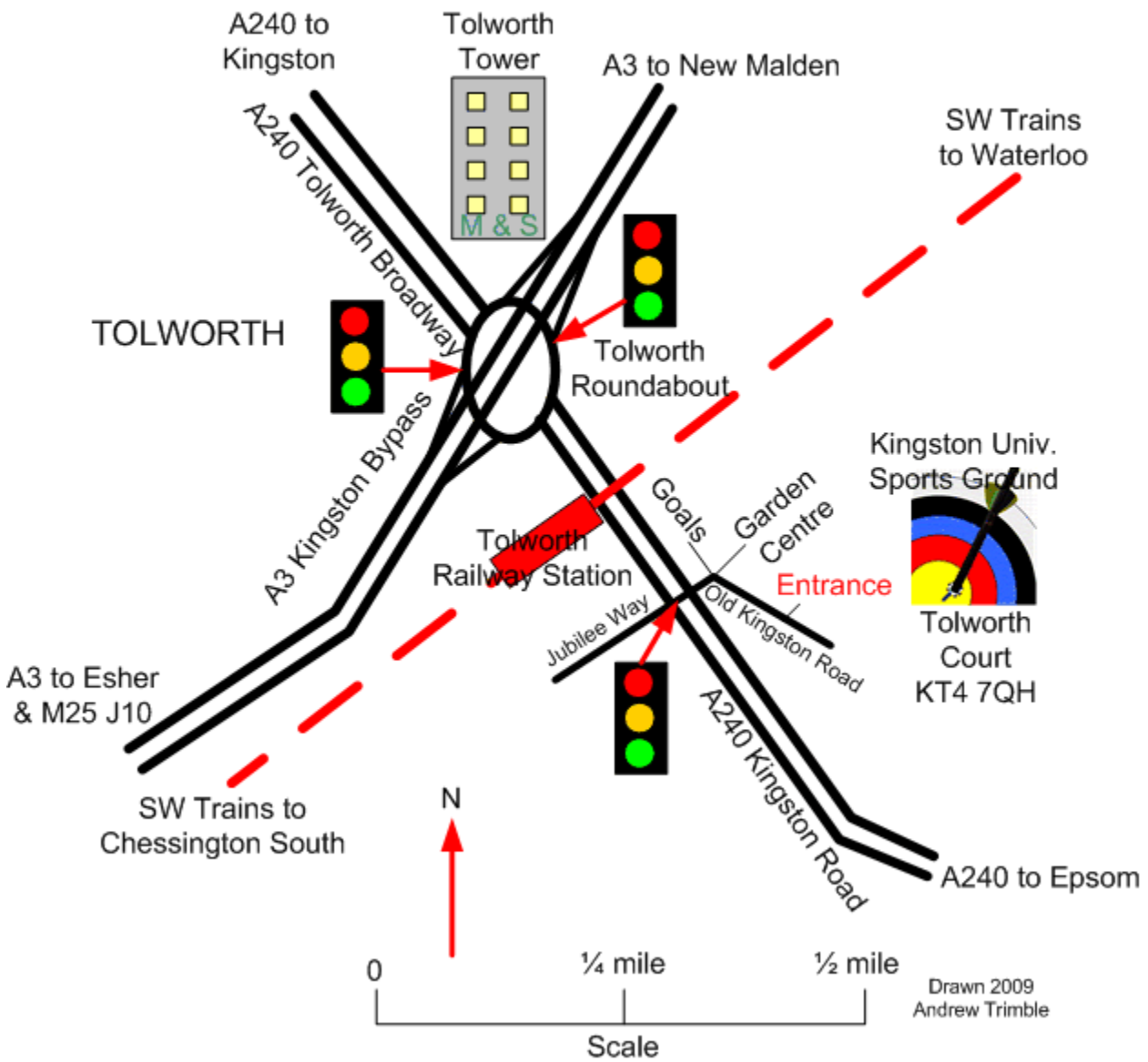

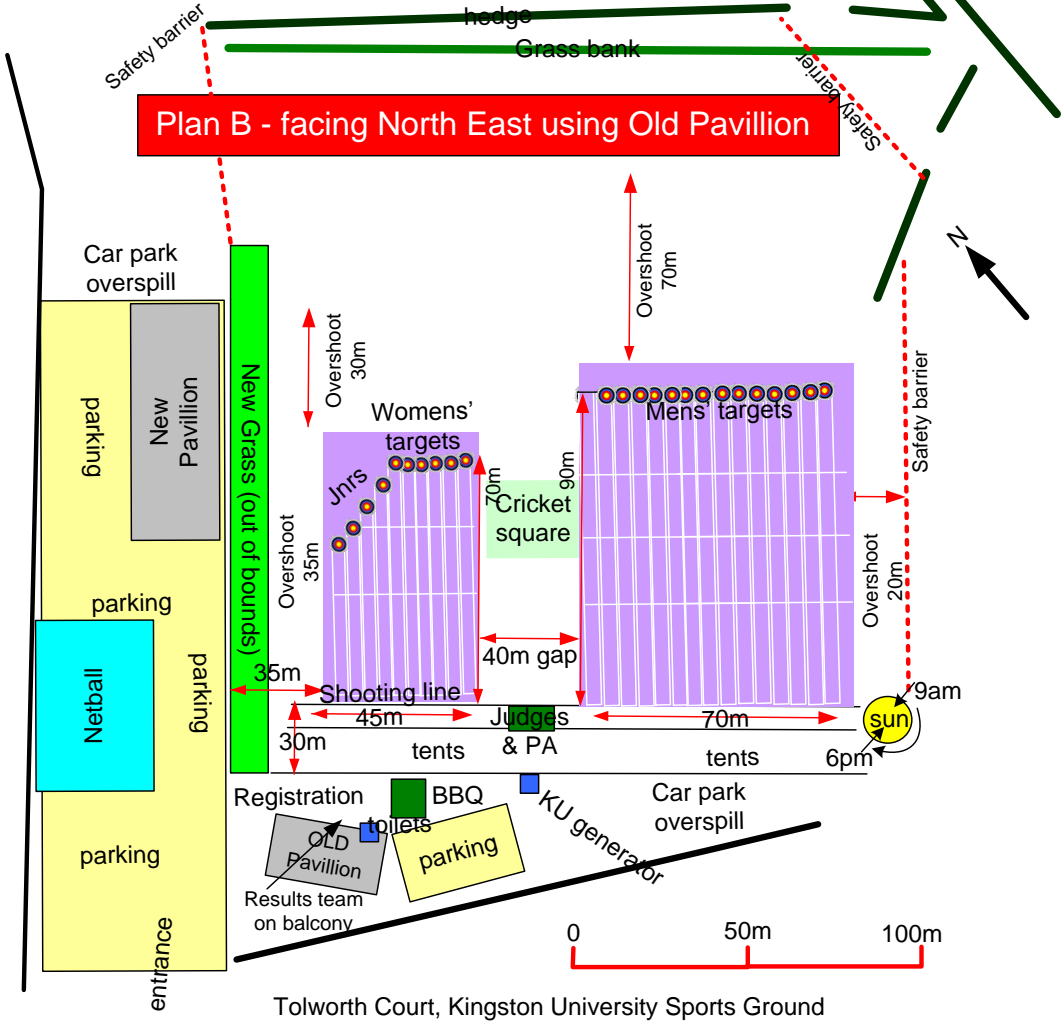
Road directions to Kingston University sports ground
